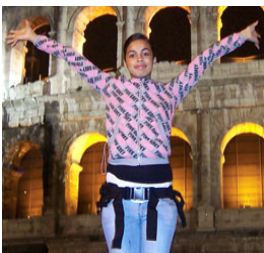
The Student-Managed Investment Fund

The Tobin College's multi-million dollar Student-Managed Investment Fund allows students, under the supervision of an advisory committee of faculty and distinguished alumni, to invest a portion of the University's endowment. Our state-of-the-art Financial Information Lab, also referred to as the "trading floor," provides student Fund managers with real-time information on securities prices and performance, earnings estimates and M&A and IPO activity.



Global Destination Studies
